ACADEMY QUICK START GUIDE TO FALL SPORTS

1. **ALL** U of D Jesuit Fall Athletes must obtain a Start of Season Clearance Form from the U of D Jesuit Athletic Office prior to their first official day of participation with any team. Form will be issued at a designated time during the summer. Check our website for updates.
2. ALL U of D Jesuit Students must have a current medical physical on file to be a registered student at U of D Jesuit. Physicals forms must be dated and stamped after April 15th of the given year. Students cannot tryout for a team with having a current physical on file at U of D Jesuit.
3. Fall sports actually get started during the summer. Although not mandatory, your teams are participating in many sanctioned events and activities throughout the summer. If you plan on participating in a fall sport you should seriously consider attending a summer camp. All athletes are encouraged to get involved in U of D Jesuit's nationally renowned speed and strength program— Iron Cubs!
4. Know the date your sport begins and be there!
