**ANSWERS TO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS
FOR PARENTS OF NEW STUDENTS GRADES 7, 8 OR 9**

WHEN ARE APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE?

Applications are available after November 1, 2016

HOW DO I RECEIVE AN APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL AID?

The application can be completed on-line at <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid> .

WHAT DOCUMENTATION DO I NEED TO APPLY?

You MUST submit to FACTS **ALL** of the following:

1. A completed application
2. To receive an *early decision* on your financial aid application, a copy of your MOST RECENT Federal Tax Return - 1040, 1040A, 1040-EZ (**2015** if applying **BEFORE** January 20, 2017). Applications submitted after January 20, 2017 must have a **2016** tax return.
3. You must include any supporting tax schedules (A, B, C, E, F) if applicable
4. You must submit a current year W-2 for you and your spouse (2016)
5. Additional information will be required for divorced, separated or single parents/guardians
6. Additional information will be required for parents/guardians who are self employed

WHO DECIDES HOW MUCH FINANCIAL AID I CAN GET?

U of D Jesuit has a committee that looks at each application and corresponding report from FACTS and makes a determination based on the information provided at the time. Tuition assistance awards can range from \$500 to approximately \$9000.

MUST I RE-APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID EACH YEAR?

Yes. Family financial situations can change, so it is mandatory to re-apply for tuition assistance each year.

WHAT ARE THE PAYMENT PLANS FOR TUITION?

There are 3 tuition payment plans available. Single payment: full tuition payment due June 10th; two payments: 50% tuition payment due in June 10 and October 10; or 11 monthly payments beginning in May 2017 and ending in March 2018.
